



## Walk One

Start	The Norway Inn TR3 7NU
Grid ref	SW775387
Distance	4 miles (6.4km)
Time	2 hours
Terrain	Tracks, lanes and woodland paths, some wet and rough
Parking	The Norway Inn
Public transport	Train via Falmouth Branch Line to Perranwell Station <a href="http://www.firstgreatwestern.co.uk">www.firstgreatwestern.co.uk</a> (to pick up route midway); bus information <a href="http://www.cornwallfirstgroup.com/cornwall">www.cornwallfirstgroup.com/cornwall</a>
Toilets	None on route
Dogs	On leads on roads and in fields



- 1 Pass to the right of the pub; follow the footpath steeply uphill to reach Church Road. Turn right past Churchtown Farm and St Piran's Church. Continue uphill, soon following the footpath downhill to Perranwell village stores.
- 2 Turn right to follow Station Road past the Methodist Church. At new houses pick up the Millennium Path, rejoining the road about 150m before the station. Follow the road past the station.
- 3 Take the first lane left to cross the railway line. Turn immediately right onto Grenna Lane. Opposite a bungalow turn left on a banked footpath. Cross a stile and small field; pass through a gate/Cornish stile in the hedge ahead. Turn right along the field edge and over a stile onto a track; turn left.
- 4 At the track T-junction (Trevella Barn) turn right. At the next T-junction turn left, (Greenwith Common), to reach a road (Coldwind Cross).
- 5 Keep ahead down a rocky bridleway to another road. Turn left for a few paces, then right on a bridlepath downhill into woodland. Cross a stream and ascend to a T-junction; follow the footpath left across damp ground. At the next T-junction turn left, soon crossing a stream via a bridge. Ignore the first path junction and ascend to another.
- 6 Turn right downhill (Chyvogue). Pass under the railway; cross a stile and continue downhill, soon crossing a field then paralleling a stream. Cross the bridge to reach a tarmac way by The Old Mill; continue uphill, soon passing the playing field. Bear half left on a footpath to reach the road by the school. Follow the footpath ahead to the next road.
- 7 Turn right up St Piran's Hill; at the crossroads turn left (Church Road). Just past The Old Vicarage turn right through a turnstile. Descend steeply to The Norway Inn.

## Walk Two

Start	The Norway Inn TR3 7NU

Distance	1¾ miles (2.8km)
Time	1 hour
Terrain	Tracks and lanes
Parking	The Norway Inn

Toilets	None on route
Dogs	On leads on roads and in fields

- 1 Pass to the right of the pub; follow the footpath steeply uphill to reach Church Road. Turn left, passing The Old Vicarage.
- 2 At the crossroads at the top of St Piran's Hill turn right, downhill. Cross the road to pick up the pavement and keep downhill over Treworthal Road; at pavement end turn left on a footpath that runs between gardens to meet a road by the school. Cross over and follow the footpath ahead. Cross the tarmac way and continue past the playing fields, then down a drive past Chyvogue House. At the Old Mill bear right on a small path that passes the garage to cross the stream, then follow the built path. Cross a field then ascend a track under the railway and through woodland to a path junction.
- 3 Follow the track right to meet the road on a bend. Keep straight on to reach Greenwith Cross. Turn right down Chapel Hill, and right again at the bottom to find the village centre.
- 4 Pass to the left of the village stores on a footpath that ascends steeply, levels then descends past St Piran's Church. Follow the lane right past Churchtown Farm, soon turning left on a footpath through a turnstile. Descend steeply downhill to The Norway Inn.
